#### SPACE FIRSTS

The first animal in space was the Russian dog, Laika. In 1957, people around the world watched on TV as Laika travelled in space in the satellite Sputnik 2.

The Russian astronaut, Yuri Gagarin, was the first human in space. Scientists launched him into space on 12th April 1961. His flight lasted 108 minutes. He orbited the Earth once at nearly 28 thousand kilometres an hour. Yuri Gagarin was born in March 1934 and died in a plane crash in March 1968.

Valentina Tereshkova was the first woman astronaut. Scientists launched her space craft on 16th June 1963. She completed some experiments. Her space craft returned to Earth and landed in Kazakhstan on 19th June 1963. She was born in March 1937.

Scientists launched Apollo 11 into space on 16th July 1969. Three astronauts: Michael Collins, Neil Armstrong and Edwin Aldrin were in it. The distance to the Moon was nearly 400 thousand kilometres. The journey lasted four days. On 20th July the Eagle space module landed on the Moon and over 600 million people watched on TV as Neil Armstrong walked on the Moon for the first time. The Eagle stayed on the Moon for 21 hours. Armstrong and Aldrin did some experiments and collected 21 kilos of moon rock. Collins waited in orbit around the Moon. On 24th July they returned to Earth. They landed in the Pacific Ocean.

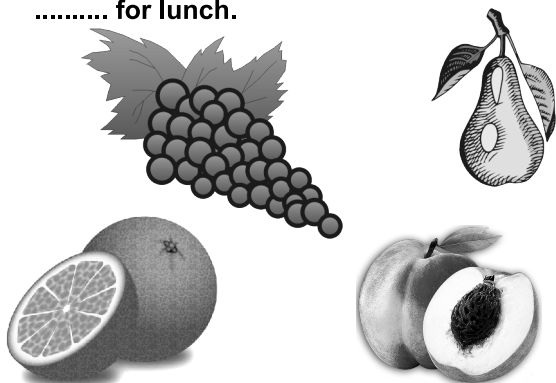
