## I. READING

London is the capital city of the United Kingdom. It's the largest city in western Europe, and the world's largest financial centre. More than 8 million people live in London, 30% were not born in the UK. London lies on the River Thames. There are 33 bridges over the river and 4 tunnels under it.

27 million tourists visit London every year. It is the world's most popular tourist destination. They come to London from all over the world to visit its attractions:

- The Houses of Parliament have 1,100 rooms and 5 kilometres of corridors. Tourists admire Big Ben, which isn't the name of the famous clock but the bell inside the tower. The clock is the biggest in the UK. Its diameter is 7.5 metres. The hour hand is 2.7
- The London Eye is a huge wheel situated next to the river, opposite the Houses of Parliament. It's 136 metres high and the views from the top are fantastic. One ride lasts half an hour.
- The Tower of London is visited by most tourists. It was built in the 11th century. It was a fortress, a palace and a prison. Now it's a museum, where you can admire the famous crown jewels. Not far from the Tower, there is Tower Bridge, which was built 125 years ago.
- At Greenwich there are famous old ships and a line on the ground which marks 0° longitude. There you can stand with one foot in the eastern hemisphere and the other in the western hemisphere.
- The Shard is the tallest skyscraper in the UK. It is 310 metres high. It was built in 2012. The building offers visitors fantastic views from the 72nd floor. The entrance ticket costs £ 35 for a child. The Shard is the most expensive skyscraper to visit in the world.
- Foreign tourists love visiting Madame Tussauds, a museum where they can see wax models of famous people from the past to the present day. The ticket costs £ 25, but most London museums are free.

Sports lovers can watch a football match at the stadium of one of the famous clubs: Arsenal, Chelsea, Tottenham, Fulham or West Ham United. They can also see the Wimbledon tennis tournament and take part in the London Marathon together with 50,000 runners. The 2012 Olympic Games were held in London. The city also hosted Olympic Games in 1908 and 1948.

The city has a fantastic underground system, which is the oldest in the world. London is also famous for its black
