Eurovision

Every year millions of people watch the Eurovision Song Contest on TV. In fact, it's probably the most popular music competition in the world. But it was very small when it started. In 1956, singers from 7 countries travelled to Lugano, in Switzerland for the first Eurovision Song Contest. Today about twenty-four countries compete in the final of the contest, and people in many more countries watch it on TV.

In the past, the competitors used their own language, but today singers can choose their language. Most competitors now sing in English.

In the past, judges from each country voted for the songs in the competition. But in 1998 telephone voting started. Now TV audiences can phone and vote for their favourite songs. You can vote for any singer, but you can't vote for your country. In 2000 people watched the Eurovision Song Contest live on the Internet for the first time!

2003 was another important year for Eurovision. A Junior Eurovision Song Contest started. The first contest was in Copenhagen, Denmark. Children from 18 countries performed, and the young singers were amazing! The winner of the first contest in Denmark was Dino, from Croatia. He has got a fantastic voice and the audience loved his song. Now he's a pop star!

The Eurovision Song Contest 2004 took place in Istanbul, Turkey. Ukrainian singer Ruslana won the contest with "Wild Dances". The Eurovision Song Contest 2008 took place in Belgrade, Serbia. Dima Bilan, representing Russia, was the winner with the song "Believe". It was the only one Russian victory in the competition. The last contest took place in Portugal in May 2018. The winner was Israel with the song "Toy", performed by Netta. This was Israel's fourth victory in the contest.

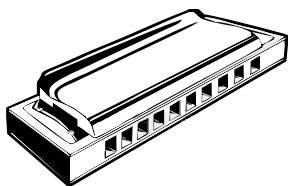
