Joanne Kathleen Rowling (J. K. Rowling) is a British writer, who wrote the Harry Potter novels. Her first book about Harry was entitled Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone.

Joanne grew up in Chepstow, Gwent. She has always wanted to be a writer. Her first book was called Rabbit. She left Chepstow for Exeter University, where her course included one year in Paris. As a postgraduate she moved to London for two years to work at Amnesty International doing research on human rights in Francophone Africa.

She started writing Harry Potter after the idea came to her on a Manchester-London train journey. By the time she got off at King's Cross station, Harry's story was planned as a seven book series and many of the characters in the books had already been invented. She wrote during her lunchtimes in cafés and pubs and prayed that none of her workmates would have birthdays so that she'd have to go to the pub with them instead.

Jo then moved to Oporto in Portugal for three years to teach English as a foreign language, married a Portuguese journalist, and became pregnant. By the time her daughter Jessica was born, her book was one-quarter finished.

Back in a tiny flat in Edinburgh, now divorced and unemployed, she still continued to write at the local café, while her infant daughter slept. The Scottish Arts Council then gave her a grant that enabled her to finish the book and, in June 1997, five years after its conception, Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone was published by Bloomsbury Children's Books.

J. K. Rowling has won awards for the Harry Potter series of books and has earned over \$1 billion. The last book of the series - Harry Potter and the Deathly Hallows was released on 21 July 2007. Due to the popularity of the books, Rowling has become very rich; she is said to be the richest woman in the United Kingdom. Joanne married Dr Neil Murray in 2001.
