In August, thousands of people in Buñol, Spain celebrate the festival of La Tomatina. The festival begins with fireworks and a parade. Later, people stand in the streets and throw tomatoes at their friends and neighbours. They throw about 125.000 kilos of tomatoes! It's great fun!

Every year in February or March, people in Venice, Italy celebrate the Carnival. They wear fantastic costumes and masks and have colourful parades in the narrow streets of the city. There are parties all around the city, and people dance and sing in the streets. One of the biggest parties is in St. Mark's Square. You can go to the square and celebrate with thousands of people.
