Thanksgiving is a special holiday in the USA. It's on the fourth Thursday in November. At Thanksgiving, American people remember the history of their country. They have family parties. The traditional Thanksgiving dinner is turkey, sweet potatoes and pumpkin pie.

New Year's Eve is on 31st December. British people often meet their friends and go to parties. At midnight they kiss their friends, watch fireworks and sing a traditional Scottish song called Auld Lang Syne. In London a lot of people go to Trafalgar Square and the River Thames to watch fireworks.

Valentine's Day is on 14<sup>th</sup> February. In the UK and the USA, it's a day of love! People send romantic cards but they don't sign their names. There are often little poems in the cards. People sometimes give presents too, like flowers or chocolates.

Diwali is a national holiday in India and Nepal. This is a festival of light. Everybody lights little lamps in homes and streets. Indian people eat special spicy food and sweets. They also send Diwali cards.
