Arjuna's day at school is quite ordinary. He has lessons in the morning, and then lunch at school. Mum makes sandwiches for him. In the afternoons, they usually do sport. Arjuna isn't really interested in sport and he hates rugby. He isn't keen on playing football like other boys.

In the evenings, he does his homework, then he plays computer games. He also loves reading and playing chess. At 9.30 his dad tells him to go to bed. But he usually stays up for another three quarters of an hour, and then goes to bed.
