Akio Morita (26 January - 3 October 1999) - co-founder of the Sony Corporation.

He created one of the first truly global companies. His strategy was so successful that Sony was recently voted the number one brand name by American consumers, ahead of Coca-Cola and General Electric.

Morita had a comfortable childhood. He was the eldest son of a wealthy family from Nagoya. He trained as a physicist. Before he celebrated his 26th birthday, he had started his own company with a partner Masaru Ibuka. In 1949 the company developed recording tape and in 1950 sold the first tape recorder in Japan. In 1957 it produced a pocket-sized radio and a year later renamed itself Sony. For the new name Mr Morita combined the Latin word for sound „sonus” with the English expression „sonny boy” to give an impression of a company full of energy and youth. In 1960 it produced the first transistor television in the world.

He moved his family to the USA in 1963. This helped him to understand Americans, their market and customs. Many people believe this was the key reason for his global success. Sony launched the Walkman in 1979 after Morita had noticed young people's love of music.

Morita loved art and music, and was a sports fanatic. He also wrote a book in the 1960 s called „Never mind School Records” which argued that academic achievements are not important for success in business.
