An amazing journey

Ernest Shackleton was born in 1874 in Ireland. When he was 10, his family moved to England. After he left school, he decided to be an explorer. In 1907, he tried to reach the South Pole. but he wasn't successful.

Then, in 1915, he decided to walk across Antarctica! He sailed from Britain with twenty-seven men in a ship called *Endurance*, but near Antarctica the sea froze around the ship and trapped it in ice. Shackleton and his men stayed with the ship for eleven months. They had no contact with Britain, but they had lots of food,

The ship finally sank and the men moved onto the ice. They took the life boats with them. They lived on the ice for five months, but there wasn't much food now, and it was very cold.

Finally, Shackleton decided to leave the ice. He and the men travelled 160 km in the lifeboats to Elephant Island in the South Atlantic. It was a terrible journey in the cold and wind. They waited on Elephant Island, but they didn't see any ships.

Shackleton decided to leave the island with five men. It was a very dangerous journey. They sailed 1,500 km to South Georgia Island to get help at the whaling station there. There were people there. Three months later, they returned to Elephant Island and rescued the other men. The amazing thing is, all men survived!
