#### I. READING

How many sports do you like? How many sports are you good at? Jessica Ennis is a British heptathlete. She became a heptathlete in 1997, when she was eleven. The heptathlon is an outdoor athletics competition. In Greek 'hepta' means 'seven' and 'athlon' means 'contest'.

This means that Jessica does seven sports in athletics competitions. The seven different events are: 100 metres hurdles, high jump, shot put, running 200 metres, long jump, javelin and running 800 metres. Heptathletes score points for each event. The person with the highest score wins the competition. The outdoor heptathlon is only for women athletes.

Jessica started athletics at school when she was a teenager. She enjoyed all the sports, so she trained at all of them! Therefore it wasn't a difficult decision to become a heptathlete. Her favourite sport of the seven is running and she finds javelin the most difficult.

Jessica became World Champion in 2009 when she was only 23. The next year she became European Champion. Then, she was World Champion in 2011 and 2015. She also became Olympic Champion in 2012. She won the gold medal for the heptathlon in the London Olympics. The next year she won another award – the CBE (*Order of the British Empire*) – from Queen Elizabeth II for services to athletics. Finally, Jessica won the silver medal in the 2016 Olympic Games in Rio de Janeiro.




